



## **ACCESS TO WARREN COUNTY SECONDARY ROADS**

NO ENTRANCE OR ACCESS SHALL BE PERMITTED IN THE SECONDARY ROAD RIGHT OF WAY WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE COUNTY ENGINEER OR HIS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE.

YOU MUST MARK THE LOCATION OF THE REQUESTED ACCESS.

SIGHT DISTANCE WILL BE CHECKED. A NEW ENTRANCE MUST HAVE A MINIMUM SIGHT DISTANCE OF 500' EACH DIRECTION ON UNPAVED ROADS AND 600' EACH DIRECTION ON PAVED ROADS. THE APPROVAL OF A DRIVEWAY LOCATION DOES NOT INDICATE THAT IT IS SAFE FOR A SCHOOL BUS, GARBAGE TRUCK, OR OTHER VEHICLES TO STOP ON THE TRAVELED PART OF THE ROAD.

WARREN COUNTY WILL DETERMINE IF A CULVERT IS NECESSARY AND, IF SO, THE DIAMETER AND LENGTH OF THE PIPE CULVERT REQUIRED. ALL CULVERTS MUST BE NEW CORRUGATED METAL PIPE AND THE DIAMETER AND LENGTH WARREN COUNTY SPECIFIES.

THE DESIGN AIDS TABLE IN DOT'S INSTRUCTIONAL MEMORANDUMS TO COUNTY ENGINEERS 3.210, SHOWS CROSS-SLOPES OF 6:1 ON ENTRANCES LOCATED ALONG PAVED FARM TO MARKET ROADS WITH LESS THAN 1,000 VEHICLES PER DAY. IT SHOWS 8:1 CROSS-SLOPES (TAPER TO 6:1 AT THE CULVERT PER STANDARD ROAD PLAN RL-7) ON ENTRANCES WHEN THE CURRENT ADT IS OVER 1,000. WARREN COUNTY'S LATEST AVAILABLE TRAFFIC COUNTY MAP SHALL BE USED IN DETERMINING REQUIRED SLOPES.

THE ENTRANCE CAN BE INSTALLED BY WARREN COUNTY AT AN AVERAGE COST OF \$300.00 ON GRAVEL ROADS/\$350.00 ON PAVED ROADS PLUS THE COST OF THE PIPE. THE PROPERTY OWNER SHALL PROVIDE FILL MATERIAL WITHIN 200 FEET OF THE INSTALLATION. IF FENCE IS INVOLVED, YOU MUST CUT YOUR OWN FENCE. IF THE PIPE CULVERT IS PURCHASED FROM WARREN COUNTY AND DELIVERED TO THE SITE BY WARREN COUNTY, THERE WILL BE A \$50.00 DELIVERY CHARGE.

A STATEMENT WILL BE MAILED TO YOU THAT INDICATES IF A DRY FILL OR CULVERT IS REQUIRED AND THE COST INVOLVED. PAYMENT FOR THE PIPE CULVERT, INSTALLATION OR DELIVERY MUST BE MADE PRIOR TO THE INSTALLATION.

YOU MAY HAVE YOUR OWN CONTRACTOR INSTALL THE ACCESS, BUT IT MUST BE TO WARREN COUNTY'S SPECIFICATIONS (SEE BACK OF THIS SHEET FOR DETAILS). YOU MUST NOTIFY US ONCE THE ACCESS IS INSTALLED SO WARREN COUNTY CAN INSPECT THE WORK.

GRANULAR SURFACING IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PROPERTY OWNER.
