

Warren County Health Services Receives Grant from Warren County Philanthropic Partnership



Warren County Health Services used grant funds to purchase an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) that was placed on the first floor of the Warren County Administration Building. AED's are used in emergencies to check a person's heart rhythm. If a person is suffering from cardiac arrest, the AED will deliver a shock and voice prompt bystanders to provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation or CPR until Emergency Medical Service personnel arrive. Placing AED's in public places where people work and play has been proven to increase survival rates and save lives. Warren County Wellness Committee members pictured above became "AED Champions" and were trained in AED use.
